**EXPANSION OF THE PORT OF TILBURY - "TILBURY2"
STATUTORY CONSULTATION ON A PROPOSED APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT
CONSENT
SECTION 46 PLANNING ACT 2008**

In accordance with section 46(1) of the Planning Act 2008 ("the 2008 Act"), this letter notifies the Secretary of State that Port of Tilbury London Limited ("PoTLL") intends to submit an application under the 2008 Act for an order granting development consent for the construction, operation and maintenance of a new port terminal and associated facilities near to the existing Port of Tilbury, known as Tilbury2 ("the proposed application"). The project will be located on the western part of the former Tilbury Power Station in Thurrock Council's area and includes the following main elements:

- a new roll-on roll-off ("Ro-Ro") terminal;
- a facility for importing and processing bulk construction materials;
- improvement of, and extensions to, the existing jetty;
- dredging of berth pockets and immediate approaches;
- external storage areas;
- a new link road; and
- a new rail spur and sidings to provide rail access to the Tilbury2 site.

PoTLL will be undertaking a statutory consultation on the proposed application in accordance with sections 42 and 47 of the 2008 Act from Monday 19 June 2017 until Friday 28 July 2017.

In accordance with section 46 of the Act, the following documents are hereby supplied to the Secretary of State. These comprise the same information in relation to the proposed application as PoTLL would supply to the Secretary of State for the purpose of complying with section 42 of the Act if PoTLL were required by that section to consult the Secretary of State about the proposed application:

- a copy of the consultation letter sent to consultees identified pursuant to section 42(1)(a)-(c) of the 2008 Act;

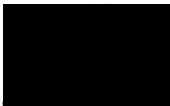


- a copy of the consultation letter sent to consultees identified pursuant to section 42(1)(d) of the 2008 Act;
- a copy of the notice published in accordance with section 48 of the 2008 Act; and
- a USB stick including:
 - a copy of PoTLL's Consultation Booklet, which provides a summary of the background to the Tilbury2 proposals and the need for the project, together with details of the proposed application, further information on how you can provide your comments and a brief summary of the next steps; and
 - copies of a plan showing the proposed Order limits within which Tilbury2 would be constructed together with a number of illustrative engineering drawings showing the Tilbury2 proposals as they are currently understood. These are subject to change as the scheme is further developed and in order to take into account comments made during this consultation; and
 - a Preliminary Environmental Information Report (and non technical summary) to help consultees understand the likely effects of the construction and operation of Tilbury2.

It should be noted that the consultees identified pursuant to section 42(1)(d) of the 2008 Act were sent a hard copy of the Consultation Booklet and the plan showing the proposed Order limits, as opposed to the USB stick. However, the consultation letter made clear how the full suite of consultation documents could be accessed and viewed.
