Development Consent Order Application Errata

Further to the Planning Inspectorate's procedural decision to accept the above application for Examination and the accompanying issue of section 51 advice and the Planning Inspectorate's section 55 checklist; the Port of Tilbury London Limited ('PoTLL') has been carefully considering and working through the matters identified and raised.

This consideration has been undertaken alongside our own detailed check of the application documentation in order to identify any typographical errors, or omitted and referenced information, that it is considered it would be helpful to correct or supply. This is in order to aid clarity and consistency within the application documentation and to ensure that the fullest amount of information that is available is provided.

As such, having undertaken both exercises, as well as receiving helpful further information from third parties, through on-going engagement and dialogue, I enclose a number of updates to the application documentation for publication on the project page of the PINS website. These can be found in two hard copies and on 6 USB sticks.

I am sending these through to you now in the anticipation that if they are able to be uploaded to the website, interested parties will be able to consider them in formulating their relevant representations, ensuring they are dealing with the most up to date and most comprehensive documentation available to date.



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I can confirm, however, that the enclosed set of documents does not deal with the query raised by the Planning Inspectorate in relation to the cumulative assessment of Tilbury2 with the Lower Thames Crossing (LTC). This is because PoTLL is currently considering the LTC Scoping report produced subsequent to the finalisation of the PoTLL statutory consultation and finalisation of the PoTLL ES and DCO application documentation.

PoTLL anticipates that it will make submissions on this point early in the Examination process; but would note at this point the low level of information provided in the Scoping report, but which does at least confirm the lack of temporal overlap between the projects as is explained in Tilbury 2's Environmental Statement.

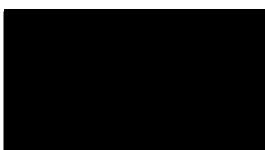
