## Tilbury 2 Potential site visit locations in Gravesham

Potential locations:

- Pontoon for Gravesend –Tilbury Ferry
- Lower St Andrews Gardens
- Promenade adjacent to Sailing Club and Heritage Quay
- New Tavern Fort
- Canal Basin
- Top of Windmill Hill
- Shornemead Fort

It would be helpful if the site visit could be organised (i.e. mid-afternoon start) so that the examining authority can see the current lighting visible from the southern shore – albeit that would be more useful if the PoTLL erected a temporary lighting pole with an example of the lighting proposed. Equally recognise that this is problematic at this time of year due to longer days and shorter nights
