Dear Sir/Madam

RWE writes in response to the Examining Authority's First Written Questions, issued on 27th February 2018.

Specifically, RWE has been asked to respond to question 1.0.16 in relation to the surrender of an Environmental Permit (Permit) at the Tilbury Power Station site. The Permit (ref: [EPR/EP3433LZ](#)) regulated the operations of Tilbury B Power Station, in terms of emissions. Tilbury B Power Station is in the process of being demolished and the Permit is no longer required. RWE is seeking a partial surrender of the Permit on the Tilbury 2 site because the land has already been remediated to the standard required by the Permit. The Permit will be surrendered, in full, following completion of demolition on RWE's retained land.

RWE confirms that the application to surrender the Permit, in so far as it relates to the Tilbury 2 site, will be made by the end of March 2018. The Environment Agency has a 3 month period to assess the application and issue the surrender notice. RWE has been in ongoing discussions with the Environment Agency and it is not aware of any obstacles that would prevent the surrender of the Permit, at the end of this determination period.

RWE also notes that the Examining Authority has asked the applicant to provide the height of the recently demolished Tilbury Power Station stacks (Q1.0.15). RWE confirms that each stack (2 stacks) is approximately 171 metres in height.
