KCC Local Road Network. In the SoCG between the Applicant and KCC at deadline 3 [REP3-028], under matters under discussion, the SoCG states that KCC considers that there will be an impact on the highway network and requests that further information is provided as to the forecast number of HGVs on the KCC highway network. Also, the Applicant awaits a response from KCC on the additional information that it has provided regarding the availability of train paths.

KCC response

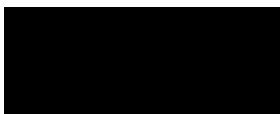
