











GENERAL SPECIFICATION FOR COLOURS AT TILBURY 2

All colours are proposed as standard RAL colours

It is required that a minimum of 2 main cladding colours are used for structures within the Order limits, with a minimum of 1 detail colour used for entrance / loading doors / building entrances / canopies.

Paint finishes will remain necessarily subject to the technical specification and safety needs of the structure, including:

- colours can be locally deviated from the pallet for safety purposes.
- in the marine environment, colours must be the best match to the cladding palette that can be reached within the context of the water and scour protection requirements of those structures.
