Please find the submission of the Applicant for Deadline 1 enclosed.

This submission consists of a number of enclosures and separate documents which are submitted in compliance with Deadline 1 in the timetable issued by the Examining Body ('ExB') on 23 November 2021, as follows.

1. Answers to the ExB's first round of written questions

1.1. The document with reference TR030006/D1/1 contains a table with the questions asked of the Applicant by the ExB and their references together with the Applicant's answers.

1.2. Some of the answers are supplemented with documents, as follows:

1.2.1. Question 1.0.1 – this requested A3 copies of the application drawings; these have been provided to the Planning Inspectorate;

1.2.2. Question 1.0.8 – this asked about current uses of the site, which are shown in plan AME-008-00088A, submitted as document TR030006/D1/2;

1.2.3. Question 1.0.13 – in answering this question a revised HRA report is provided as document TR030006/D1/3 and a corrected version of UES Appendix 11-2 is provided as document TR030006/D1/4;

1.2.4. Question 1.0.15 – this asked about planning policy; the relevant policies are included in document TR030006/D1/5;

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- 1.2.5. Question 2.0.1 – this requested a mark-up of the original Development Consent Order (as so far amended) to show the changes proposed in the DAO as tracked changes – this is provided as document TR030006/D1/6;
- 1.2.6. Question 2.0.3 – the currently proposed DML variation application is provided as document TR030006/D1/7;
- 1.2.7. Question 3.0.3 – the monitoring plan approved by the MMO is provided as document TR030006/D1/8;
- 1.2.8. Question 5.0.4 – the locations of requested habitat types are shown on plan AME-036-30006, provided as document TR030006/D1/9;
- 1.2.9. Questions 6.0.1-6.0.5 – an updated Water Framework Directive assessment is provided to supplement the answers to these questions as document TR030006/D1/10;
- 1.2.10. Question 6.0.3 – a Dredge Disposal Benthic Invertebrate Scheme has been agreed with the Environment Agency and is provided as document TR030006/D1/11;
- 1.2.11. Question 6.0.6 – this requested updated SediChem work is provided as an excel spreadsheet with reference TR030006/D1/12;
- 1.2.12. Questions 9.0.1-9.0.6 – the answers to these questions are provided in a separate report as document TR030006/D1/13;
- 1.2.13. Questions 9.0.7-9.0.9 – the answers to these questions are provided in a separate report as document TR030006/D1/14 and associated figures are provided as document TR030006/D1/14/F;
- 1.2.14. Question 11.0.1 – an updated Marine Written Scheme of Investigation is provided to supplement the answer to this question as document TR030006/D1/15.

2. Comments on relevant representations

- 2.1. The document with reference TR030006/D1/16 contains the Applicant's response to the 14 relevant representations that were made.

3. Revised Draft Amendment Order

- 3.1. A revised Draft Amendment Order (DAO), whose only revision is to reflect the additional construction sequencing option mentioned at the Preliminary Meeting and provided to the ExB that day, is provided in PDF and Word formats with reference TR030006/D1/17 (clean version) and with reference TR030006/D1/17/T (tracked version) .

4. Draft Statements of Common Ground

4.1. The ExB requested eight Statements of Common Ground; these have all either been signed (2) or agreed with the other party (6). Annex A to this letter sets out the status of each one. ABP (Commercial) has not been in touch since the Preliminary Meeting.

5. Other matters

5.1. The Applicant is not making any changes to protective provisions, so there is no submission for the item 'Revised Protective Provisions';



5.3. For the avoidance of doubt the Applicant would wish to be present at the ASI, and to speak at any future Issue Specific Hearings and Open Floor Hearings (but is not requesting either of these);

5.4. The ExB has not requested any further information; and

5.5. The Applicant is grateful to the ExB and case team for removing surplus documents from the Examination Library and has no further comments to make pursuant to the ExB's letter of 2 December 2021.
