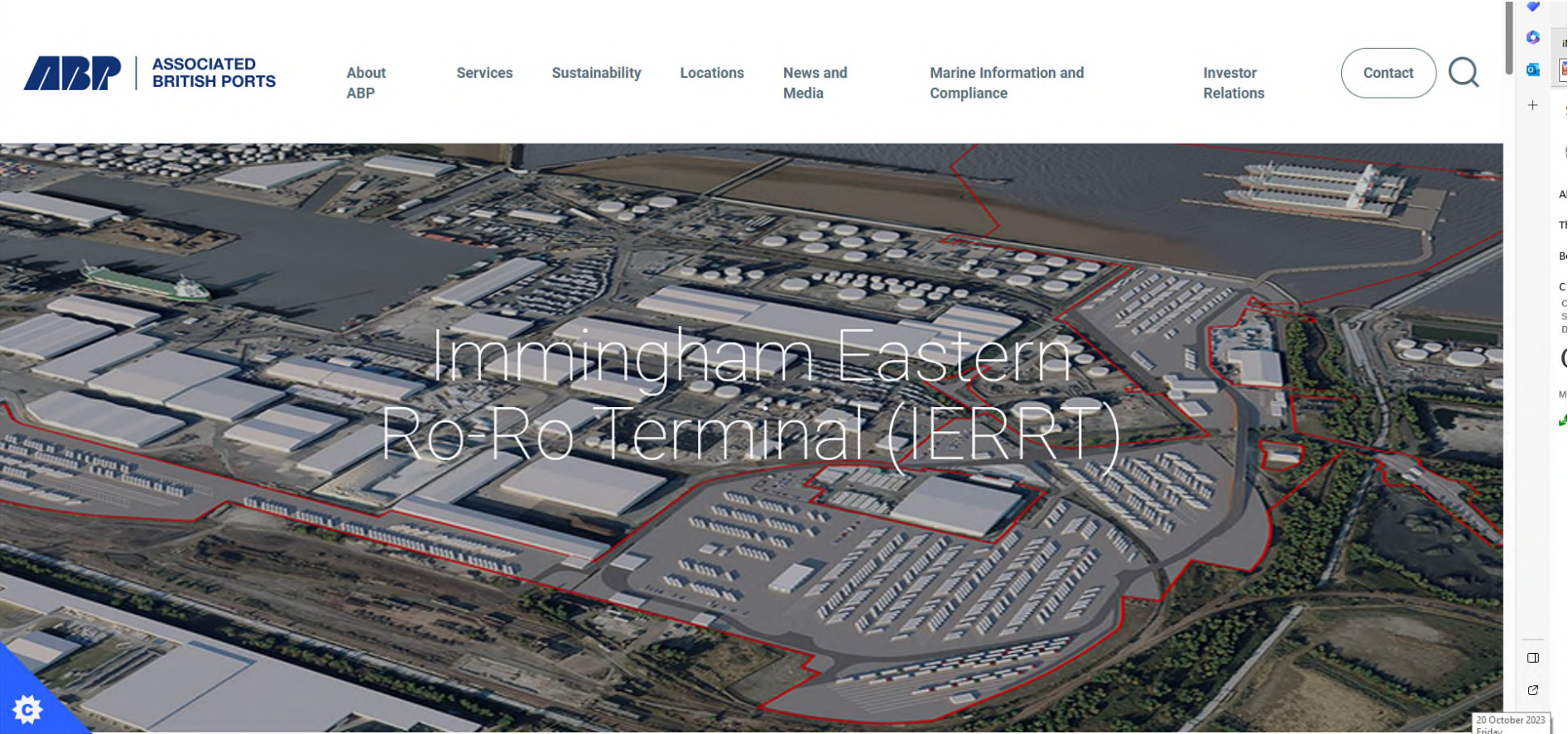

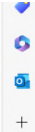

ABP's application for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') for the IERRT project has now been accepted for Examination by the Planning Inspectorate, acting on behalf of the Secretary of State of Transport.

In February 2023, we submitted our application to the Planning Inspectorate for their consideration, and we now have confirmation that the application has been accepted as validated. The IERRT project is, therefore, now entering a new phase of the DCO application processes, known as the 'Pre-Examination' phase.

An application for an Order granting development consent has been made under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 by **ASSOCIATED BRITISH PORTS** ("ABP") of **25 BEDFORD STREET, LONDON, WC2E 9ES** to the Planning Inspectorate (on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport) ("the Application"). The Application was submitted on 10 February 2023 and was accepted for Examination by the Planning Inspectorate on 6 March 2023 (Application Reference: TR030007). The Examination began on 25 July 2023 and is due to close by 25 January 2024. After the Examination has closed, the Examining Authority will submit a report to the Secretary of State for Transport who will then make the decision as to whether to grant the Development Consent Order.

THE IERRT DEVELOPMENT

The Application is for development consent to construct and operate a new three berth Roll-on/Roll-off ("Ro-Ro") cargo facility in the Port of Immingham, North East Lincolnshire, DN40 2LZ ("the IERRT Development"). The Application submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for the IERRT Development consisted of:

Marine works

- An approach jetty from the shore linked to two floating pontoons appropriately secured in position.
- Two separate finger piers to provide three berths thereby enabling the vessels to berth alongside with their stern ramps resting upon two floating pontoons.
- A capital dredge of the new berth pocket.
- Disposal of dredged material at sea if no beneficial alternative can be identified.
- Possible impact protection measures if required.

Landside

- Demolition and redevelopment of a number of existing commercial buildings within the site.
- Improvement of the existing cargo storage areas, including resurfacing and provision of new pavements and associated infrastructure.
- Provision of a terminal building and a small welfare building to provide appropriate facilities for terminal operational and administration staff, lorry drivers and passengers.
- A small workshop with fuel station.
- Facilities for the UK Border Force.
- An internal bridge within the site to cross over Robinson Road and the ABP managed transit sidings.
- Related utilities and operational infrastructure.

Introduction

This Newsletter updates on our proposals to develop a new three berth Roll-on Roll-off ('Ro-Ro') facility in the Port of Immingham since the submission of our application for a Development Consent Order ("DCO") on 10 February 2023 ("the Application").

Our DCO Application was accepted for Examination on 6 March 2023, and is currently part way through the six-month Examination period - which began on 25 July 2023 and is due to close by 25 January 2024.

As the project has evolved, we have identified four changes that we wish to make to the Application ("the Proposed Changes") in order to optimise the scheme.

The Current Position

As noted above, our Application is currently proceeding through Examination and is being thoroughly assessed by the Examining Authority

As a consequence, we now propose to apply to the Secretary of State, through the Examining Authority, for permission to make four changes to the Application ("the Proposed Changes"). These are summarised below under the heading 'Changes to the Scheme'.

Before we submit our request to make the changes, however, we are undertaking a wide-ranging public consultation on those changes.

This consultation will run between **Friday 20 October** and **Sunday 19 November 2023** during which we are inviting written comments on the proposals.

This will give you the opportunity to provide your views on our Proposed Changes - all of which, as you will see, involve changes to the scheme within the Port.

Proposed Changes to the Scheme

The Proposed Changes are summarised below and full details are provided in the 'Proposed Changes Notification Report' which will be available to view, free of charge online from **20 October 2023** at: www.abports.co.uk/immroro/consultation.



Introduction

This Newsletter is designed to provide you with an update as to ABP's proposals to develop the IERRT - a new three berth Roll-on Roll-off ('Ro-Ro') facility in the Port of Immingham.

Having considered and taken into account all the comments and representations that were received in response to the Supplementary Statutory Consultation which was undertaken in October and November last year and which helpfully informed the final details of the project, ABP submitted its application for the IERRT Development Consent Order ('DCO') to the Secretary of State of Transport c/o the Planning Inspectorate ('PINS') in February 2023. That application has now been accepted for Examination under Application Reference No. TR030007.

The Current Position

As the Secretary of State has decided that the IERRT application has been validly made and should proceed to Examination, the project has now entered a new phase of the DCO application processes – known as the 'Pre-Examination' phase.

The DCO Application Process

As we have explained in our previous Newsletters, Development Consent (as opposed to planning permission) is the effect of the alteration is expected to increase the capacity of the existing facilities by more than 250,000 units (as is the case with IERRT), then the application must be processed as an NSIP. As explained in previous Newsletters, the application process for development consent for an NSIP is not the same as applying for a planning permission, and instead falls under the remit of the Secretary of State's decision-making powers.

In due course, the Application will be subject to what is known as 'Examination'. This will be undertaken over the course of a six-month period by either a single, or in some cases more than one, Inspector, known as the Examining Authority (ExA). The ExA will be appointed by the Secretary of State through PINS.

Prior to the commencement of the Examination stage, however, ABP is required to notify all relevant prescribed bodies, interested parties, stakeholders and the local community that the Application has been accepted for Examination and to invite them to make what are known as 'relevant representations' – whereby any party/body may give notice of an interest in, or objection to, the Application.

Members of the public are, therefore, able to register with PINS to become an Interested Party by making a relevant representation and details as to how this should be done are provided below.

The ExA will be appointed during this Pre-Examination stage and a venue for the examination will be selected – somewhere in the general locality.

Interested Parties who have registered by making a Relevant Representation will then be invited to attend a Preliminary Meeting
