Since specific bird species have been identified in the scoping report that can migrate between the project area and Denmark, it is the Danish Environmental Protection Agency's expectation that the project's impacts, including disturbance and displacement in both the construction and operational phases, loss of habitat and foraging area, etc., on populations of these species, will be fully explained in the upcoming environmental impact report and handled in the further process.

The Danish Environmental Protection Agency has no further comments and does not wish to follow the project further in the process of environmental assessment.

and the unit: Circular economy and waste:

"It should be included, whether the imported ammonium is to be treated as waste during the transboundary shipment. If the shipment is considered waste the Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 of 14 June 2006 on shipments of waste (the WSR) would apply. If not, other relevant legislation and the consequences thereof should be considered."
