**LOCATION: Immingham Green Energy Terminal**

Thank you for your consultation on a proposed application for Development Consent Order, for the installation of Immingham Green Energy Terminal. West Lindsey's

West Lindsey District Council in principle supports renewable energy development and the reduction of the local and national carbon footprint. West Lindsey's made previous representations setting out their primary consideration of the impact of the construction, operation and decommissioning phases on the local highway network if traffic was to be directed through parts of West Lindsey.

Chapter 11 of the Environmental Statement states that *"no HGV traffic is proposed to be routed through West Lindsey District, with the majority of workers (80%) assumed to be distributed within North East Lincolnshire. The traffic generation and distribution is set out within Section 11.7"*.

This demonstrates that the highway network of West Lindsey would be highly unlikely to be unacceptably harmed by the different phases of the development. West Lindsey would recommend that the Highways Authority at Lincolnshire County Council is consulted for comment.
