Denmark thanks for the notification regarding the project "Immingham Green Energy Terminal" and wants to participate in the further environmental assessment process.

The notification has been sent for consultation to several Danish authorities and interest organizations and has been published on the Danish Environmental Protection Agency's website.

#### Authorities

- The Environmental Protection Agency; the units: Circular Economy and Waste have this comment:

"In the transboundary screening from spring 2023, you describe how you would import ammonium to be stored and processed at the site to create green hydrogen.

On page 296 you have written the following: "When operational, the Project would receive consignments of refrigerated liquid anhydrous ammonia delivered via ship to an offloading jetty where it would be transferred for storage in tanks onshore prior to use. Hydrogen gas would then be produced by the conversion of ammonia, which would then be liquefied for filling into bulk road tankers which would deliver hydrogen to users".

The Danish EPA had initially written, that it should be included, whether the imported ammonium is to be treated as waste during the transboundary shipment. If the shipment is considered waste the Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 of 14 June 2006 on shipments of waste (the WSR) would apply. If not, other relevant legislation and the consequences thereof should be considered.

It is still not present in the report, 1) whether the ammonium is considered waste, and 2) if the ammonium is not waste, what other legislation is relevant and what are the consequences of importing the ammonium as a product."
