The Hearing will be a blended event, whereby the principal means of conducting the Hearing will be face-to-face within the venue cited above. The ExA will not accept representations at the Hearing in the form of video or audio recordings.

The agenda is for guidance only. It is not designed to be exclusive or exhaustive. The ExA may add other issues for consideration, may alter the order in which issues are considered and will seek to allocate sufficient time to each issue to allow proper consideration of them. Any lack of discussion of a particular issue at a Hearing does not preclude further Examination of this issue, including the asking of further Written Questions.

At the Hearing the ExA is looking for the Applicant, Statutory Parties and Interested Parties to provide additional evidence to what is already in Examination. The ExA may also request parties to provide an explanation or clarification of evidence and representations submitted previously. The ExA will lead on the questioning, not allow repetitive representations, and not allow cross questioning.

5. Construction Effects

 - Traffic impact from its use, focusing on its relationship with surrounding land use and businesses.
 - Proposed mitigation measures from any environmental effects arising from its use and how these measures would be secured, along with measures for re-instatement of land once construction work has been completed.

6. Cumulative Effects

The ExA will ask the Applicant and participating IPs questions related to the following matters:

- Cumulative transport effect with IERRT and VCCS and clarification on the Applicants submitted assessment at Deadline1.
- Cumulative socio-economic effects with IERRT and VCCS, to include employment and housing-related issues.

7. Draft Development Consent Order

- i. The Applicant will be asked to provide a brief overview of the recent changes to the dDCO and the EM.
- ii. ExA will ask questions of the Applicant and IPs in respect of Articles and Schedules of the dDCO, including:
 - Interpretations.
 - Article 3 Update on discussions with NELC, Environment Agency and Harbour Master.
 - Article 9 Justification of need for article and exploration of NELC concerns.
 - Article 19 Justification as to whether the 14 period is sufficient.
 - Article 21 Need for Article, especially given its exclusion from a number of recently made DCOs.
 - Article 30 Removal of repetition.
 - Schedule 8 Temporary prohibition or restriction of the use or diversion of streets or public rights of way.
- iii. The ExA will ask questions of the Applicant and IPs in respect of Schedule 2, in particular;
