

## Prescribed consultees

On behalf of Associated British Ports (ABP) (“**the Applicant**”) and Air Products (BR) Limited (“**Air Products**”), I am writing to inform you that the Applicant intends to submit a further request to the Secretary of State to make a small number of minor changes (“**Proposed Further Changes**”) to the application for a Development Consent Order (the “**Proposed Further Change Notification**”) for the proposed Immingham Green Energy Terminal and associated development at the Port of Immingham (the “**Application**”), submitted on 21 September 2023 (Planning Inspectorate Reference TR030008).

The Application was accepted for Examination on 19 October 2023 and the Examining Authority, acting on behalf of the Secretary of State, was appointed on 31 October 2023. The Examination commenced on 20 February 2024 and is due to close 20 August 2024.

You have either previously been identified as a statutory consultee for the purposes of section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 and/or as a relevant consultation body or person for the purposes of Regulations 11 and 13 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017, and/or have been identified as a statutory undertaker that may have apparatus in the vicinity of the Application. You are therefore receiving this letter because the Applicant considers you may be affected by the proposed further changes to the Application.

On 3 May 2024, the Applicant submitted to the Examining Authority (the “**ExA**”) an application to make minor changes to the Application (the “**First Change Application**”). The ExA issued a procedural decision on 14 May 2024 to accept those changes into the Examination. For the avoidance of doubt, the changes proposed in the Proposed Further Change Notification are additional to the changes set out in the First Change Application and the ExA will determine separately whether to accept these further changes into the Examination.
