As you know we act on behalf of the Applicant in relation to the application for a development consent order (the "**Application**") for the construction, operation and maintenance of the IGET and its Associated Development (the "**Project**"). The Application was originally submitted on 21 September 2023 and accepted for Examination on 19 October 2023, which has since commenced on 20 February 2024.

This letter has been prepared to accompany the Applicant's submissions to the Examining Authority ("**ExA**") at Deadline 4 (4 June 2024) of the Examination. These submissions are made in accordance with the Examination Timetable set out at Annex A of the Rule 8 Letter dated 28 February 2024 [**PD-007**].

1 Overview of Deadline 4 Submissions

- 1.1 Submissions made at Deadline 4 comprise the documents requested in the Rule 8 Letter, as well as other information, documents or updated documents either requested by the ExA or which the Applicant wishes to be submitted as part of the Examination.
- 1.2 Any updated documents supersede the documents previously submitted by the Applicant. The Guide to the Application submitted at Deadline 3 has been updated to reflect all of the submissions and updates at Deadline 4.

2 **Applicant's Further Proposed Changes Notification, Consultation and Application**

2.1 Further to the Applicant's letter dated 9 May 2024 to the ExA regarding the consultation to be carried out on Proposed Further Changes to the Application **[AS-031]** (the "**Proposed Further Change Consultation Advice Letter**") and the Applicant's Further Proposed Change Notification made on 21 May 2024 **[AS-038]** the consultation for the Proposed Further Changes commenced on Tuesday, 21 May 2024 and will run until 23:59 on Wednesday, 19 June 2024. As set out in paragraph 3.3 of the Proposed Further Change Advice Letter and paragraph 3.2 of the Applicant's Proposed Further Change Notification the Applicant will then fully consider all responses it receives to the consultation by the 19 June deadline and intends to submit its Proposed Further Change Application to the ExA on 26 June 2024.

3 **Updates on draft planning agreement and unilateral undertaking made in accordance with S106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("TCPA")**

3.1 The Applicant is submitting updated drafts of the Section 106 agreement for payment of contribution towards woodland compensation **[REP3-077]** and the Section 106 Unilateral Undertaking relating to habitat compensation at Skeffling **[REP3-078]**.

4 **Early Works Applications Report Update**

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- 4.1 As set out in the Applicant's cover letter to its D3 submissions **[REP3-001]**, an application under the TCPA was submitted 28 March 2024 and validated 28 March 2024 by NELC (reference DM/0326/24/FUL) for test piling on the West Site to inform the piling methodology and a decision was anticipated on or around Deadline 4. In its D3 submissions cover letter, the Applicant committed to providing a further update at Deadline 4.
- 4.2 The Applicant is submitting with these Deadline 4 submissions an explanatory note concerning the Applicant's strategy for early works (TR030008/EXAM/9.73) including the test piling application referred to above and a further application for site preparatory works which has been submitted on 23 May 2024 to NELC.
