Thank you for your consultation letter and emails dated 21 November 2024.

The submissions by the Green Energy Terminal Project (the applicant) and the positions of other statutory consultees which are summarised in the consultation documents do not directly engage the interests of Anglian Water Services or our customers. Anglian Water therefore has no comments on those matters.

The Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) between the applicant and Anglian Water dated 15 August 2024 set out Anglian Water's support for the project given its planned contribution to net zero transition. The SoCG set out that two matters were not agreed. The first of these relates to the supply of water to the project which is a matter that is 'ongoing' given Anglian Water's regulatory limits which mean that there is no guarantee that water will be able to be supplied to the project and their selected water retailer either during construction or operation. The second matter is 'not agreed' as the applicant disagrees with Anglian Water on the need for a Water Resources Assessment (WRA) pre commencement Requirement in the DCO Order. That inclusion of a Requirement in DCO Orders and a similar planning condition in TCPA planning permissions will now be mandatory for nationally significant and major development which requires a significant volume of water for non- domestic purposes such as cooling or process water. The WRA Requirement provides a mechanism for the applicant to show they have maximised water efficiency as part of final post approval design work and so provide evidence to Anglian Water, the decision maker, the Environment Agency, and others that the provision of that quantum of non- domestic water supply to the project would not compromise future supply to domestic customers. The ability to ensure uninterrupted water supplies to domestic customers is Anglian Water's and other water companies' primary regulatory duty.
