Sirs

This proposal, which by the way initial work has already commenced, seriously impacts the town of Askern, though no mention of this fact is within the report.

The freight rail line cuts the village in two, and already at peak times has traffic backed up to the A19, causing disruption. The result of the additional traffic, will mean additional closures of the crossing on Station/Moss Road, estimated at the moment to increase to eight crossing per hour. Elderly residents are very concerned that the bus service which would be impacted will result in its cessation due to the delays.

This disrupts Police and Ambulance access to the residents lower than the freight line, and Fire to the residents higher than the fright line.

No consultation has taken place with any of the affected residents or businesses, and this we feel is totally unacceptable without the provision of alternative access, which is not in their current proposals.
