|  | <p>The following advice was provided to the attendees of the drop-in:</p> <p>The relevant representation form can be completed online on the IPC website, or a hard copy can be requested by calling the IPC helpdesk on 03034445000. The representations must be submitted to the IPC by 5pm on 9 September 2011.</p> <p>Registering at this stage enables a person (or organisation) to become involved in the examination stage of the process by becoming an 'interested party' and take part at the Preliminary Meeting. At this stage a brief description of issues should be provided, these can be explained in more detail later, at the examination stage through written representations and/or oral representation to the appointed Examining Authority at the Preliminary Meeting or at the hearings.</p> <p>The examination stage can take up to six months. It is estimated that the shortest amount of time that an examination may take is approximately 4 months, due to statutory deadlines.</p> |
