EXQ1 BIO.1.2. Toads at Lodway Farm

As well as there being the toads at Lodway Farm, I am also concerned for the welfare of the other wildlife in the fields at Lodway Farm. My garden backs on to Lodway Farm and I have a wildlife camera that takes photos of animals coming into my garden from the field at night. On a regular basis, I have photos of foxes, [redacted] and deer. We regularly see bats flying about and a wide variety of birds. I have attached a couple of examples below.
