
Dear Rob,

Many thanks for your letter of 3rd August 2018 regarding the above.

Birmingham City Council was consulted as part of the Stage 2 consultation under section 42 and responded to Four Ashes Ltd on the 30th October 2017. In this regard there is a general summary of the City Council's response at paragraphs 10.2.3 to 10.2.6 in the Consultation Report. The City Council also set out its broad support for the comments of Transport for West Midlands on the proposal and again this is summarised at paragraphs 10.2.61 – 10.2.62.
