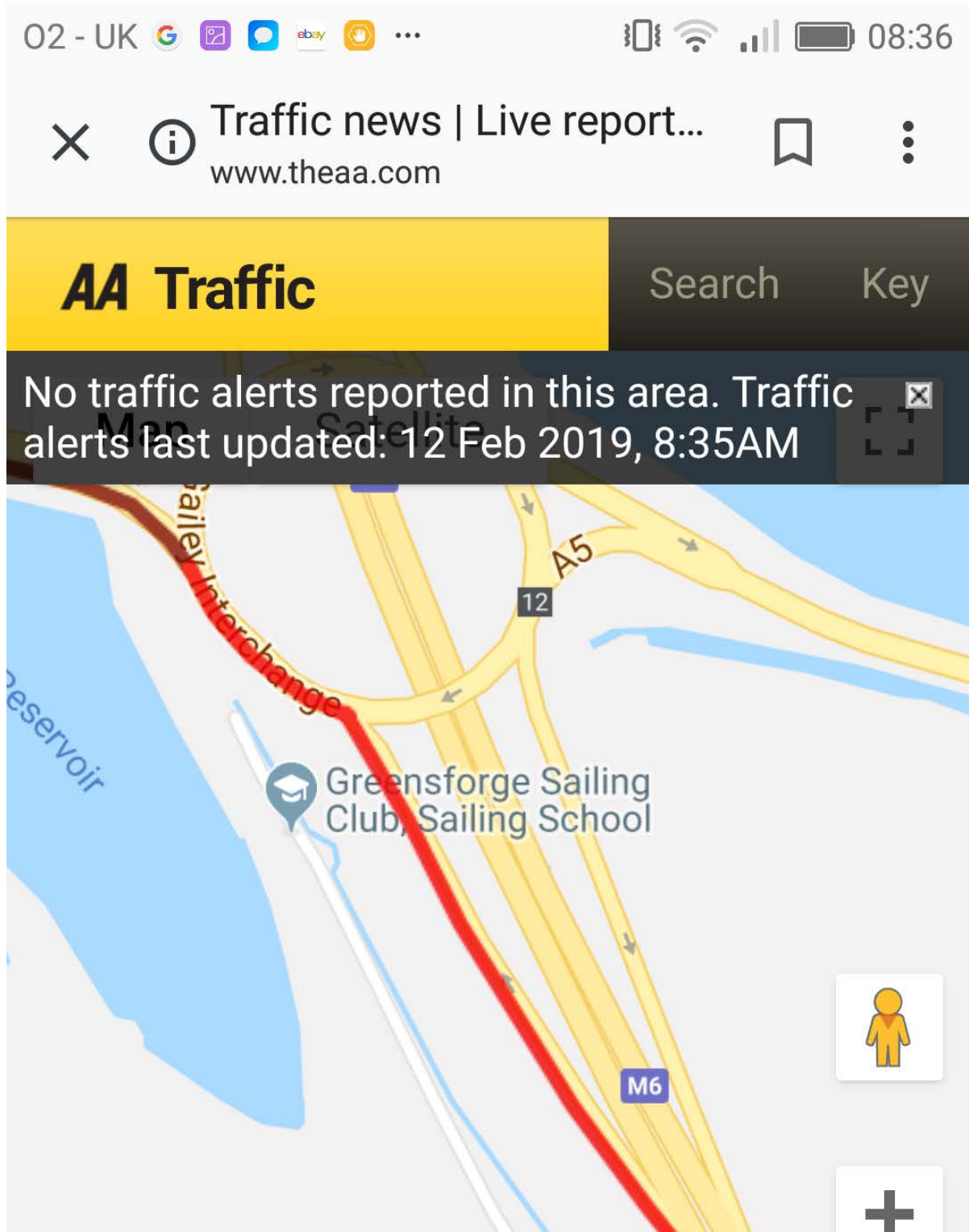
Dear Sir,

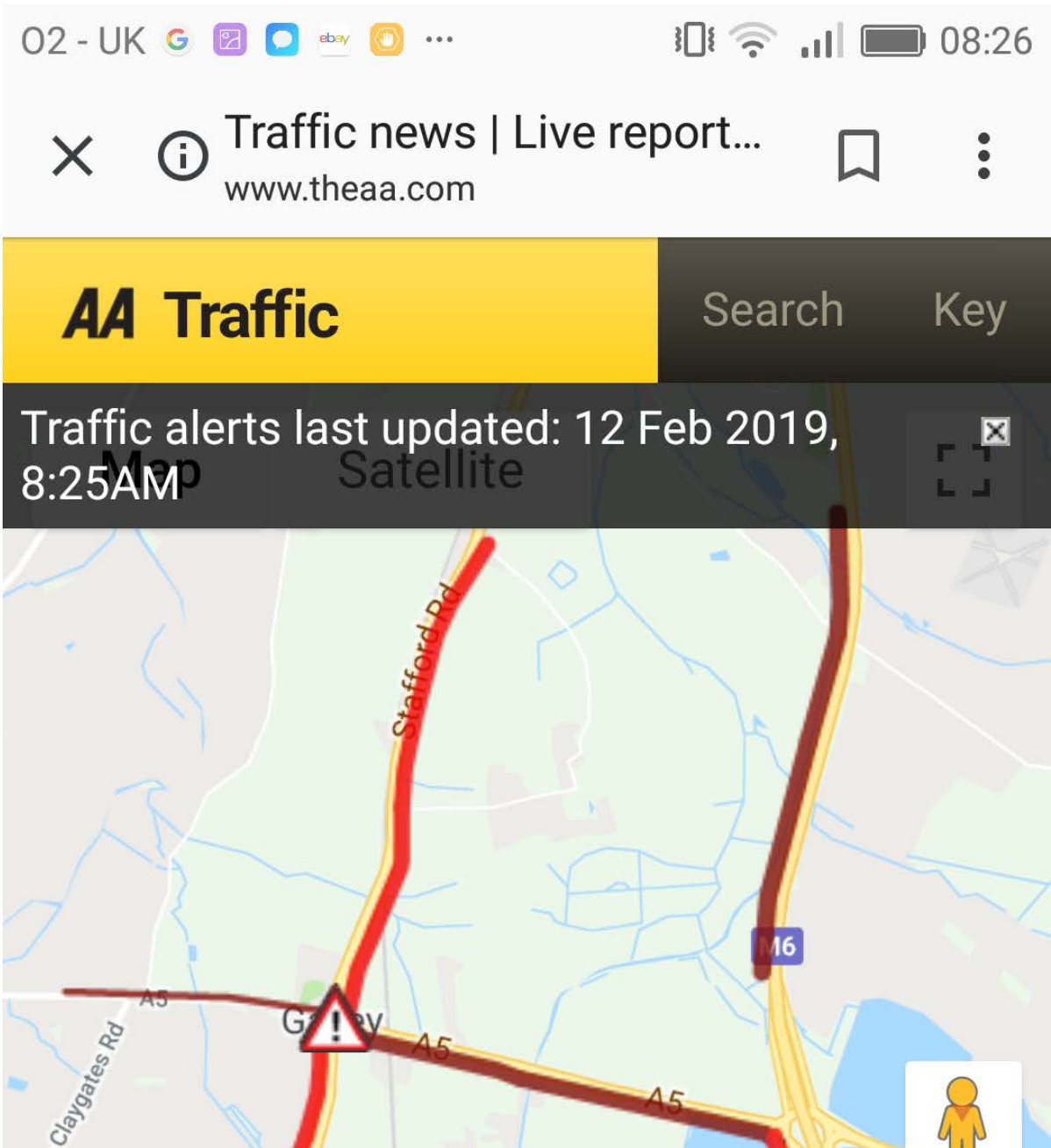
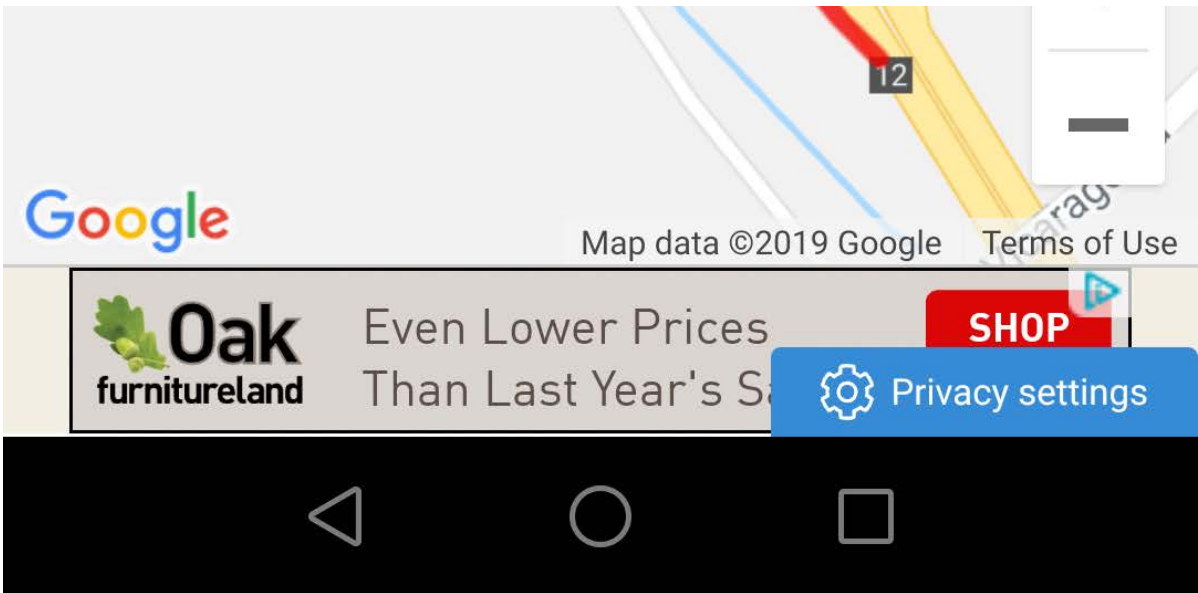

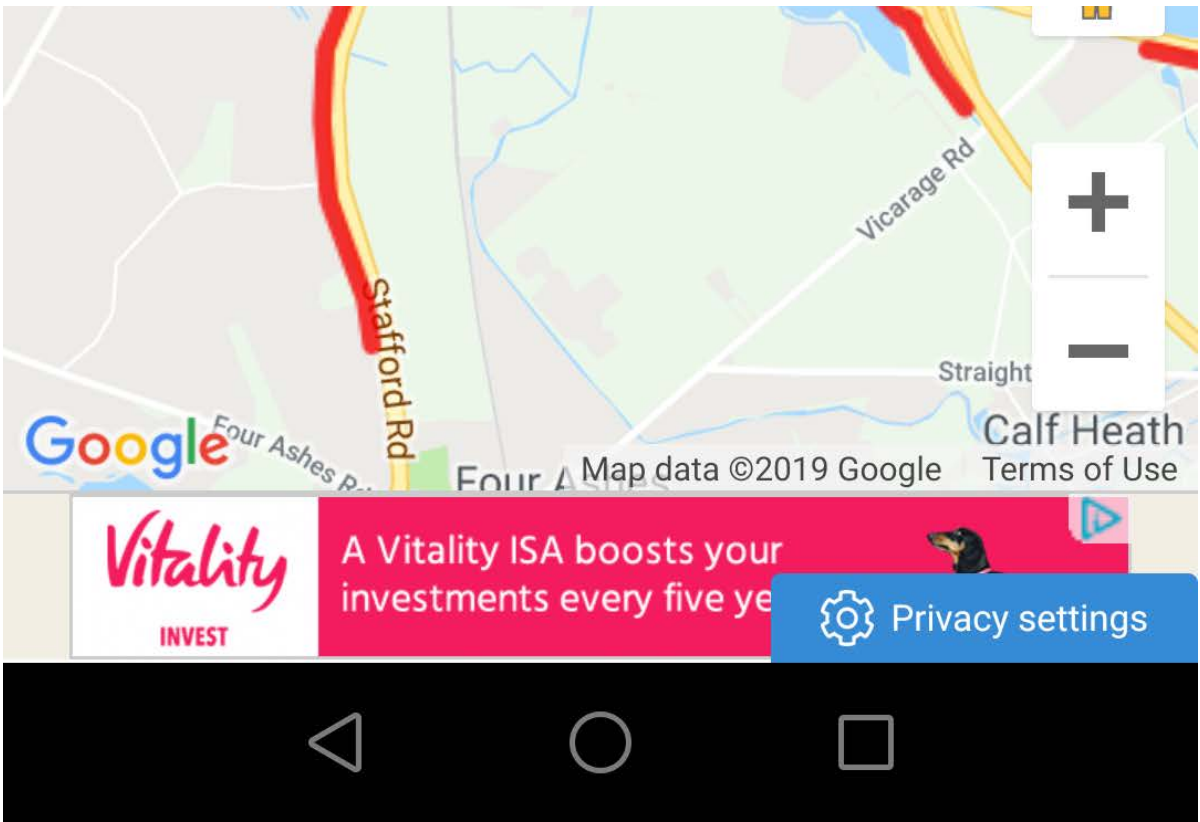
