Please find below the relevant comment for the 5th April deadline for representation from Gavin Williamson, MP for South Staffordshire in connection to the West Midlands Interchange.

I am writing to express my continued opposition to this monstrous proposal.

As stated many times before, I believe the development will cause irreversible damage to the greenbelt and see the destruction of mature woodland and natural habitat. It will also risk damaging the distinct identity and character of our villages, whilst causing traffic chaos on our roads.

In 2017, I held a large public meeting at Coven Memorial Hall which was attended by over 300 residents. At the meeting, volunteers stuffed envelopes with referendum forms which were then distributed to thousands of households in areas that would be impacted by the development including Shareshill, Featherstone, Saredon, Hatherton and Calf Heath. The referendum result showed that 99% of those who responded were against the development going ahead.

I stand firm with my constituents that this proposal is highly unsuitable and I therefore do not want to see it approved.
