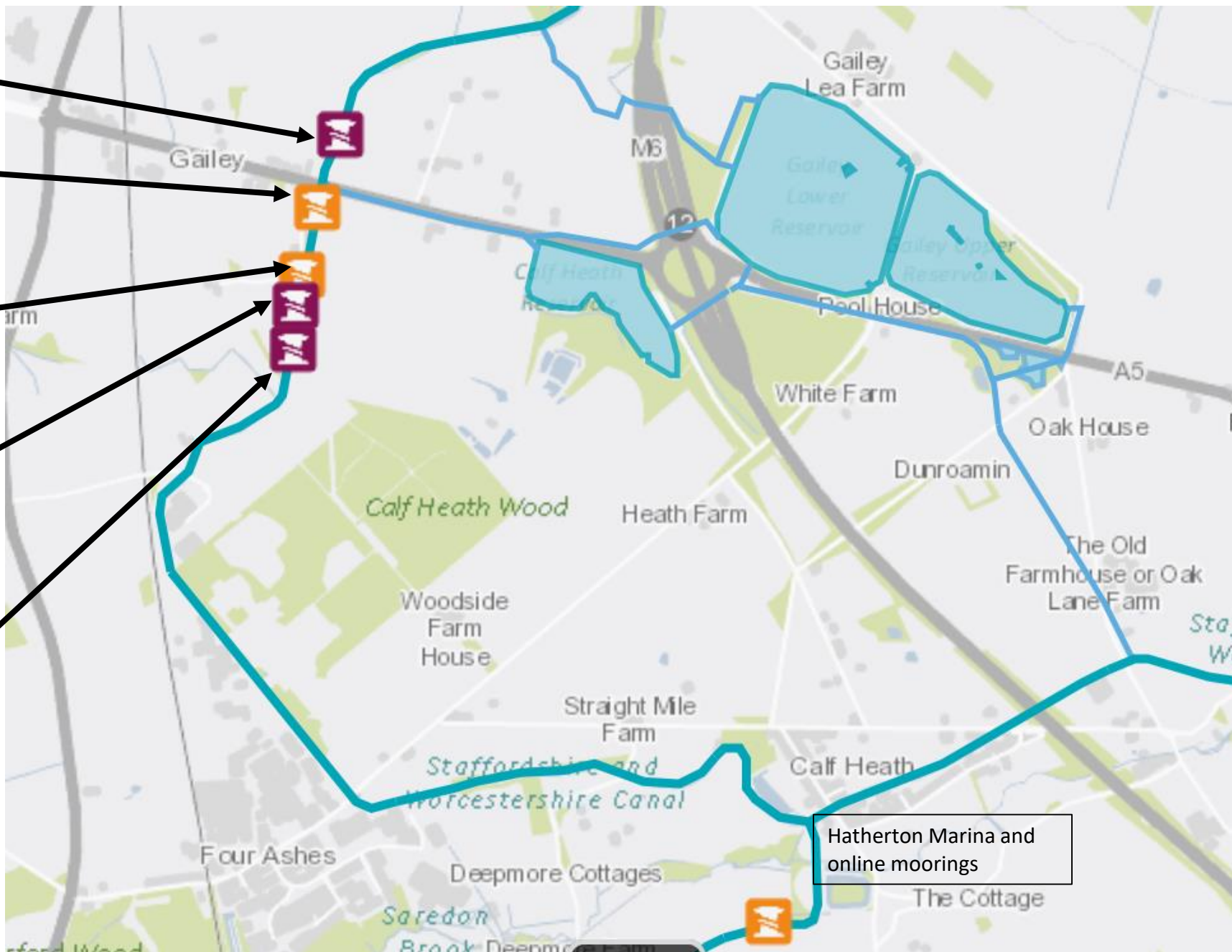

Mooring	Description
Gailey Wharf Moorings	4no. mooring points restricted to maximum 48hour stay
Gailey Marina L5 Moorings	JD Boat Services operate the boat yard and have agreement to moor along the canal from their site south along the canal to Croft lane
Gailey Wharf L1 moorings	Max 10no. Leisure moorings let on the basis of a 12month contract. Requirement to provide proof of main residence as moorings are not residential. Expectation that the boat will move from the mooring at times and the boat will not be occupied all the time. However no time restrictions are imposed and mooring can be used for leisure purposes similar to that of a holiday home.
Gailey wharf service moorings	2no. Short-stay moorings for services and shop
Gailey Bridge (79-78)	2no. Moorings restricted to maximum 5day stay and 4no. Moorings restricted to max 48hour stay.
Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal	Outside designated mooring areas boats can moor anywhere along the canal network for a period of 14days.
