There are several reasons for not building the west Midlands Interchange at the four Ashes sire.
our load unemployment figures are less than $1 \%$ so we do not need the massive building proposed to create jobs.
This proposal includes a spur of rail track from the main line. During one of the local meetuing we heard from Rail experts that due to the brain hmetable extra freight from this spur. was not viable as it was too dangerous. There is not enough time between brains bo let the freight brains out. Therefore we concluded that this Rail spur is just a tool to elevare the entire plan bo the level of Strategic Rail Freight Hub which means the plans have to go straight to the secretary of stare bypassing our Local Planning councils. our local councillors hove all objected strongly bo the plans because they have first hand knowledge of haw badly the area will be affected.
Greenbelt land is never to be built on. Farmland, lakes, woodland, rivers and canals - our blessed countryside which we all enjoy will be destroyed forever and replaced

2 by 643 dares of 30 metres high ( 98 ft ) warehouses along with tarmac roads $\%$ carparks, security lighting, street lights and 24 hour non-stop lorries. This mass of warehouses are will be dangside the canal so the many tourists who hire boars from Hatnerton, Penkriage and Brewed will no longer enjoy the countryside views across fields and woodlands.
A fundamental concern is the enormous impact the predicted 18624 lorries per 24 hours this proposal brings to such a small area. The braffic island of Gaily is already suffering from heavy congestion due to the Managed Motorway development on the Mb at Junction 13 Stafford and up towards Stoke an Trent. The $A 449$ goes through the village of Penkridge and has already had bo reduce the speed limit to 30 mph due to braffic noise. There is a children's nursery right next to the main road and if this why goes ahead then the pollution will badly affect the babies and children. There are five schools in Penkridge also, all our childrens health will suffer from the 16,3 Tons of $\mathrm{CO}^{2}$ emissions given off daily from the lorries!

Shokeen Trent is a town which has higher unemployment, also wolverhampton. The area known as the' Black Country' has so many Brownfield sires ready to be developed where jobs are needed: Tipron, Dudley, coseley all next to the mainline Rail Network. The Etruria estave in Stoke on Trent already has warehouses next bo the railbrack, surely this could be developed and more jobs provided. Because the warehouses are to be left by the construction company to be rented out, questions should be asked about who maintains the site and steps it from degrading and falling únto disrepair. Also, who

3 will keep the site from spreading litter and all the mess that industry brings?
