I am the Customer Service Manager for Kier Highways in the West Midlands and have been passed your email from Natalie Geraghty who has moved on to Kier group to manage communications. I'm sorry that it seems that you haven't received any notification of the closures to the M54. I sent out letters to people living near the work as well as emails to our stakeholders including some nearby parishes. Can you let me know which parish you represent as I want to ensure we don't get these issues again if we work between junction 3 and junction 2. I have asked if it is possible to perform traffic counts during the closures and have been advised we can count the traffic that leaves the M54 at junction 3 if you would like.
