To ensure the best use of the time available at the hearing I have prepared an Agenda (Annex 1) which sets out the main topic headings that I propose that the hearing should focus on.

As explained at the Preliminary Meeting the examination of an application for a Development Consent Order (DCO) is conducted primarily in writing with hearings held generally only where the Examining Authority (ExA) considers that these would be of particular assistance in testing parts of the written evidence and confirming the positions of interested persons on that evidence. The agenda for ISH2 has been prepared on this basis and does not seek to cover all or necessarily the most import aspects of the Transport Assessment and the potential effects of the proposed development on highway safety and the highway network. I have received a significant volume of written evidence on these matters and will take that written evidence into account in preparing my report and recommendation.

The hearing will have regard to the revised Site Wide Travel Plan [Document AS-039] and revised Site Wide HGV Management Plan [Document AS-040] which can be found in the Additional Submissions tab of the Examination Library as well as to other relevant information that was submitted with the application and at Deadlines 1,2 &3.
