I write to add my objection to the many already raised against this unnecessary distraction of a huge swathe of valuable green belt land.

In my opinion this is a cynical money-making plan on behalf of the landowner. I understand that the Applicants say they need the 6 year delay to 'generate interest' in the rail hub shows that there is no interest in at all.

To swallow up green belt land the developers must prove there is exceptional reasons to this. There is sufficient evidence that there are no exceptional reasons as there is no demand for it.

Unemployment in the area is less than 1% so new jobs is a myth.

There are alternative locations for this important rail hub that are far more suitable

The surrounding area, including a much valued and well used sailing facility will be destroyed and the infrastructure around the area simply would not cope with the increase in traffic on the village roads, especially when there is an issue on the M6 (which happens frequently).
