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I wish to lodge my strong objection to the proposed warehousing development on greenbelt land in my locality.

I don't believe that local planning authority would have allowed such a huge development of warehousing and if allowed to go ahead the local rural areas will become another part of suburbia and be lost forever. This type of development is out of keeping for area.

The site won't work efficiently as a SRFI and due to location and the chaos additional traffic would cause to the joining highways predict that the local lanes would become "short cuts" for those commuting to work. These lanes are littered with potholes and defects and are already not fit for purpose. Heavy traffic which would be caused by proposed development will drive road users to using these lanes which will worsen road safety for people living in these rural hamlets and villages.
