The application is for permission to build a Rail Freight hub. The suggestion that the rail element of the development would only be commenced once 186,000 sq mts of warehousing has been constructed makes a mockery of this being a nationally significant infrastructure project. The rail head is vital to the development and should be in place prior to any warehousing being occupied to ensure that businesses us the rail element. The developers projections for additional traffic generated by the site are modelled on use of the rail head. If it is not built untill part way through the development, or indeed ever, the projections are completely useless.

If a company moves to the site and are using road freight they are unlikely to change once the rail head becomes operational. They will have road haulage contracts in place and deals made.

Have any other RFIs been built without a Rail link being in place prior to occupation of warehousing?

Please see this application for what it is, a way for the developers to build warehousing on green belt land with no intention to ever build the rail head element. As a very concerned local resident I ask that you refuse this application. Linda Hughes
