We write to you in response to the recent notification - ExQ3 3.3.1 to express our utter disgust at this new development, regarding the Rail Hub at Four Ashes.

Living in nearby Coven we have already objected strongly to the building of the Hub from the outset and have given our reasons in previous written correspondence.

Considering that the project only passed local planning, because it allegedly met a National Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) criteria by having a rail hub link, how could it be possible for permission to be granted without having the Rail Hub link in place from the start.
