6. An updated Document List (**Document 1.3H**) reflecting the above documentation.

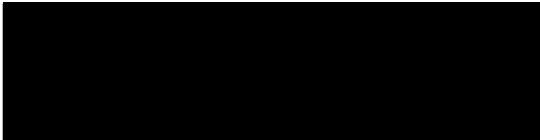
A number of the responses to Deadline 6 Submissions and to ExQ3 will necessitate some amendments to the dDCO and the Applicant will make those changes in the final DCO to be submitted at Deadline 8 in the SI Template and together with the Validation Report.

I note, as mentioned in our Deadline 4 and 6 submission letters, that one of the updated General Arrangement drawings (Plan 111, **Document 2.9K**) submitted on 21 May has still yet

to be allocated a Planning Inspectorate reference in the Examination Library, whereas all of the other drawings submitted on 21 May have been allocated a reference. Please can you confirm this will be allocated a reference number and included in the Examination Library.
