Dear Mr Singleton,

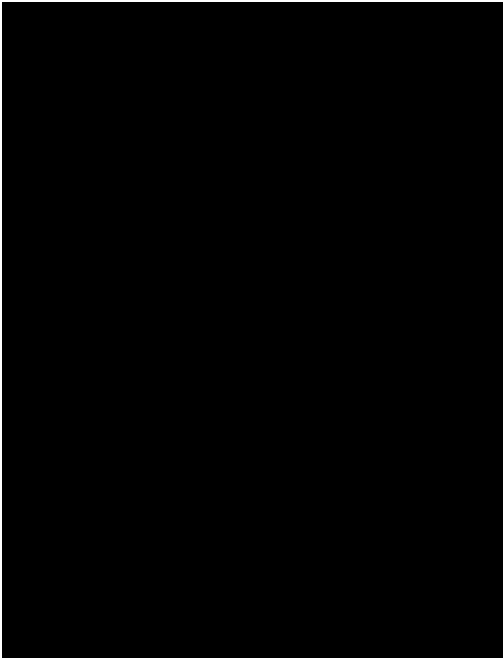
