With regard to the letter sent to you on 13th December 2019 by Eversheds Sutherland (your ref TRO50005, their ref THOMSOMO\303716-000001).

The use of the word "should" in regard to the building of the rail terminal and connections will allow for this never to be built. The development has progressed on the basis of it being a Strategic Rail Freight Interchange. If it is allowed to be developed as entirely road based freight, even in the short term, the already congested roads and motorways in the area will not cope especially if the Smart Motorway system is scrapped or revised. If the plan is to go ahead then the rail links "MUST" be completed in the shortest possible time frame.
