My main concern is about the wording "should" rather than "must"

The whole request to build on greenbelt land is due to a legality allowing the SRFI to be built on greenbelt by building a rail link so there is no question that it "should" be built it is a legality that it "must" be built before any planning is approved to build the warehouses.

It has always been the case that the landowner/developer is not interested in building a SRFI only in merely decimating almost 700 acres of greenbelt to build warehouse for financial gain.
