REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

- 1. I refer to the application made by Four Ashes Limited dated June 2022 seeking a change to The West Midlands Rail Freight Interchange Order 2020 (S.I. No. 511) as amended by The West Midlands Rail Freight Interchange Order 2020 (S.I. No. 1163) ("the Application"). The Application was published on 12 June 2023 and the Secretary of State initiated a consultation on it on the same day. The deadline for the receipt of representations was 14 July 2023.
- 2. The <u>representations received</u>¹ in response to the consultation have now been published.
- 3. The <u>Applicant responded on 5 September 2023</u> to the points raised in the representations to the Secretary of State's consultation.
