I have previously registered with you as interested party in respect of the Roxhill Northampton Gateway proposed Strategic Rail Freight Interchange (SRFI) & associated Roade Bypass proposal. My registration identification number is 20011378.

I **strongly object** to Roxhill's Northampton Gateway (Roxhill NG's) SRFI proposal for many reasons including:

If approved, Roxhill's proposal would have a highly detrimental impact to an area which already congested i.e. c. 16,500 extra vehicles each day of which c. 4,250 would be HG's. The consequences to the M1, A508 and A45 are unthinkable and Roxhill's proposed 'improvements' to the M1 (junction 15) and the addition of a bypass in Roade will not solve the congestions congestion issues created by the proposed development. If Roxhill's proposal were approved, it would significantly exacerbate the existing road traffic congestion issues.

Traffic noise in the areas surrounding the propose SRFI site and bypass in Roade will reach intolerable limits.

Roxhill's proposed SRFI would have a major adverse impact on air quality which in turn is likely to cause significant adverse health implications to all local residents who would be impacted by their SRFI and associate bypass in Roade.
