Dear Mr Asquith

I wish to register my concern re the Roxhill Northampton Gateway proposal. I have attended numerous consultation meetings on the proposal and I wish to make my views clear that I am opposed to the development on the basis of:

- additional traffic congestion
- raised noise pollution
- air pollution issues
- environmental and loss of countryside

This is a totally opportunistic development which does not fit with the planning frameworks of the local authorities. It is unnecessary given the DIRFT, The East Midlands development, the Corby lorry hub all of which provide the capacity required for freight and rail. It is not in keeping with the national strategy which does not envisage a plethora of freight terminals in the East Midlands but talks about a national framework of provision.

I live locally and am most distressed by the proposal for the health and well being of people in the area.

I note the examination timetable, and although I wrote on two occasions to formally register my concern, they do not appear to have been recorded, so I don't think I am a formal "interested party". But I am. I attach my original letter as part of the consultation to Roxhill to which I had a reply in writing to acknowledge that on 15th June 2018.

I would like to attend the site meeting. I would also like to attend the meeting on 19th Dec (ISH2) which I note is part of the examination timetable. (rule 8)
