## Response to Applicant's Response to RR-700 re Woodleys Farmhouse Day Nursery

I do not consider that 350m is "some considerable distance from the Road [sic] Bypass". Woodleys Farmhouse is far closer to the proposed Bypass site than some Identified Receptors such as Courteenhall House are to the Main Site. The setting of Woodleys is also far less "contained" than that of Courteenhall House.

There have been objections by various respondents to the disregard of Woodleys since the Scoping Opinion stage, yet it seems to be only now that the Applicant deigns to address comments on the exclusion of this Grade II listed building from the Cultural Heritage section of the Application.

Increased traffic along the A508 resulting from the proposed RFI and highways mitigation works would make access to and from Woodleys even more hazardous than it is now. The concerns of respondents about this have not been addressed either in the response to me in Part 1B or in Part 2 of the Applicant's Response.
