NRUG wish to submit the above document for consideration by the Examiners, noting page 87, where it is set out that non London freight should not pass through London and be moved off London lines. Utilising the Felixstowe/Nuneaton route is specifically mentioned.

This is consistent with the position set out by NRUG, and supports NRUG’s position that the proposed development is in an unsuitable location, stranded between two critical capacity pinch points on the rail network, Northampton Station and the north London line.
