It would appear that Roxhill Developments have not provided evidence of the impact of dust pollution on the village of Milton Malsor and surrounding areas during the construction period. There will need to be most extensive earthworks to this area, in order to satisfactorily level the ground for the construction of warehousing and rail freight connections.

The nearest houses in Milton Malsor are approximately half a mile away from the construction site, and these are sheltered housing for the elderly. All residents in the village will have to suffer poor air quality during the long construction period. I feel very strongly that we should not have to be inflicted with this sort of pollution, we have no alternative than to breath in the clouds of dust that will be caused by the massive earthworks.
