The inspectorate have written to ask our opinion regarding Roxhill's response to their queries regarding Air Pollution.

As a layman the 66 pages presented were impossible to respond to, however, knowing full well that Junction 15 is already over the Governments guidelines for Air pollution at peak times it is more than obvious that the increased traffic from container lorries, staff private vehicles (est. employment 7,000), delivery vans, etc. would increase the toxicity to an unacceptable level. No amount of tree planting and bunding will alter this.

I would, respectfully, ask is this the right time in view of the present protests about Air pollution? Also, bearing in mind that there is a school very close in Collingtree.

The East midlands is over loaded with logistic facilities. We need to remember that the original idea from the Government to increase SRFI's was to service London and the South West.
