**The Northampton Gateway Rail Freight Interchange Order 2019 (S.I. 2019 No. 1358)– Proposed non-material change**

On behalf of SEGRO (Junction 15) Limited (previously Roxhill (Junction 15) Limited) (the “Applicant”) please find enclosed an application for a non-material change to The Northampton Gateway Rail Freight Interchange Order 2019 (S.I. 2019 No. 1358) (as amended by as amended by the Northampton Gateway Rail Freight Interchange (Correction) Order 2020).

The enclosed application has been prepared in accordance with the Planning Act 2008, the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011<sup>1</sup> (as amended) (and references to a Regulation number in this letter are references to these Regulations) and Guidance on Changes to Development Consent Orders<sup>2</sup>.

The enclosures with this letter are:

1. An Application Statement explaining the proposal. This statement includes:
  - a) Background to the application;
  - b) The nature and materiality of the change sought; and
  - c) The statement required pursuant to Regulation 7A(1) concerning publicising and the duty to consult.

3. A draft amendment order.

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In respect of the information required by Regulation 4(2) we advise as follows:

- a) The Applicant is SEGRO (Junction 15) Limited (previously Roxhill (Junction 15) Limited (Company Number 08763104) whose registered office is at Lumonics House Valley Drive, Swift Valley, Rugby, Warwickshire, CV21 1TQ. This entity is the specified as the "undertaker" in the DCO following a company name change. Details of the name change are included in the Application Statement.
- b) Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP of Water Court, 116 – 118 Canal Street, Nottingham, NG1 7HF are the appointed agent.
- c) The DCO reference was TR050006.
- d) Details of the change applied for are contained in the Application Statement.
- e) The documentation considered necessary to support the application is contained in the Application Statement.
- f) The Applicant is the entity who applied for the DCO and is the owner of the majority of the land to which the DCO relates. The remainder of the land to which the DCO relates is either adopted highway or operational railway land.
- g) The statement referred to in Regulation 7A is contained within the Application Statement.
- h) No paper copies of the application have been requested.

We will provide confirmation of the publication of the notices in the press following their publication and will be writing to all consultees on 10 August 2022, advising of the submission of the application and providing them with the required details to enable them to respond. As indicated above the response deadline is 11:59 on 26 September 2022.
