RAIL FREIGHT INTERCHANGE PROJECT - NON MATERIAL CHANGE
I am a long standing resident of Blisworth, I have lived and served the community here for over 62 years, so I write to object very strongly to the underhand way that new proposal to change the project's rail terminal has crept into what would be a huge Heavy Goods Vehicle nightmare for the village,

All our roads in and out of the village are very busy all the time, the many road junctions and lanes are already too narrow to use some of the larger delivery lorries .

The footpaths and pavements were very narrow and uneven, having been put in many years ago. Ordinary access for our school children from all over the village as well as those who use the various School Buses would be put in danger if the proposes amendments to the original project was allowed to go ahead.

If SEGRO is allowed to do as it likes and ignores the original commitment it will be breaching national government policy

Blisworth and all its precious heritage is too valuable to be squashed by all the warehouses, the HGVs and the financial gain that could be made from a speculative build.
