## Re: Adequacy of Consultation Request-Hinckley National Rail Freight Interchange Project

Thank you for your letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2023 regarding the above reference scheme. We note that the letter invites us to comment on whether or not SMBC considers that the Applicant has complied, in relation to the application, with the following duties:
