The first point to make is that the diagrams 5.9 to 5.11 (in APP-138) which show the affected roads are very hard to follow and are of a scale which makes this exercise almost impossible to fathom. However, as a result of representing this area for 50 years I believe I can identify most of the affected roads, albeit the impacts are difficult to fully assess.

As any major change to the road network should result in a lessening of impact can I please express my concern that according to the submitted diagrams there will be more traffic attracted to the following roads:

- Outlands Drive pm only
- Clifton Way (part)
- Florian Way

- Lismore Drive
- Stoke Road
- Tudor Road
- Brookside pm only
- Netherley Road
- Stoneygate Drive
- Middlefield Lane

Finally, I find it hard to understand that there will be no increase of traffic travelling along the M69 towards Junction 21 of the M1 or less traffic travelling on the A5 and Normandy Way heading towards Tamworth etc.
