Please see below our requests for additional location inspections

Location – Stream running along the back of the numbers 6,7,8,9,10,16,17 and 18 of Bostock close

Visit type - Unaccompanied ( However residents may request individual accompanied visits to view the stream from their properties)

Reason – This area is downstream of the flood risk zones 2 and 3 area noted in plan 2.11B ‘ Existing Utilities, features & Areas of Influence – Sheet 2’ – residents have to regularly clear the stream themselves to reduce the risk of flooding to their properties.

Time – Following heavy rainfall , or a period of persistent rain.

Location - Junction of Bostock close with the B581.

Visit type – Unaccompanied

Reason – Proposed unaccompanied crossing site due to relocation of PRow . Poor visibility of road , number of road traffic incidents have occurred in this area in recent years, speed of traffic, bridge on approach – the crossing is proposed to be at the base of the bridge, width of pavement, width of road – namely when two heavy goods vehicles are passing.

Time – Rush hour

Location - Trainline and proximity to houses on Bostock Close , in particular 6,7,8,9,10,16,17 and 18

Visit type - Unaccompanied ( However residents may request individual accompanied visits to observe issues from their properties)

Reason – Noise and Vibration from passing trains , concerns no sound barriers will be put in place to reduce this with increase of trains and length.

Time – Anytime

Location- The length of the B581 on foot through the Elvesthorpe

Visit type – Unaccompanied – On foot

Reason – Speed of traffic, width of pavement, width of road specifically with heavy good vehicles, volume of traffic.

Time – Rush hour

Location - Burbage common road

Visit type – unaccompanied – on foot

Reason – flooding and proximity to flood risk zones 2 and 3 area noted in plan 2.11B ‘ Existing Utilities, features & Areas of Influence – Sheet 2’ , traffic, use of the road , proximity of proposed site to livery / houses.

Time – following heavy rainfall or a period of persistent rain.

Location - Top of bridge on b581

Type of visit – unaccompanied – on foot

Reason speed of traffic , location of many road traffic incidents in recent years, width of pavement, width of bridge, issues with two heavy good vehicles passing on bridge , location of junction at base of bridge causing traffic to stop which cannot be seen on approach, bridge as a slight bend which can result in cars skimming the armco barrier to avoid other cars.

Time - Rush hour

Location - Location on B581 ( we have used What three words to advise on exact location) between and **growth.flotation.coil** and **secondly.strutting.node**

Type of visit – unaccompanied – on foot

Reason - speed of traffic , location of many road traffic incidents in recent years including 1 which involved significant injury to a horse, width of pavement.

Time - Rush hour

Location – Roundabout at junction of New Road, Long Street , Broughton Road and Sapcote Road in Stoney Stanton.

Visit type – unaccompanied – on foot and in vehicle from all directions of traffic.

Reason - Poor view from some directions of travel , high volume of traffic, high volume of heavy goods vehicles, high volume of pedestrians in area,

Time- 3-4.30pm weekdays

Location – All junctions onto B581 within Elmesthorpe

Visit type – Unaccompanied

Reason –Poor visibility, speed of traffic, concerns regarding heavy goods or plant vehicles using side roads error or as parking and as none of the roads that join the B581 are through roads or have the space to turn a large vehicle around they would have to reverse back out.

Time – anytime

Location - Narborough crossing

Visit type – unaccompanied

Reason – down time at the crossing , volume of traffic

Time – rush hour

Location - Junction 21 m1 / m69 – rush hour

Visit Type – unaccompanied

Reason – volume of traffic in both directions during rush hour, the previous visit to this location was completed outside of rush hour. When travelling southbound on the M1 in morning rush hour around 7.30am the traffic can queue as far as junction 22. When travelling onto the M1 from the M69 in either rush hour the traffic queue is regularly over 4 miles

Time – both rush hours and both directions
