Procedural Decision on Site Inspections

The ExA would like to thank all those who have taken the time to suggest locations for to visit and points to note. These have helped us formulate the approach to site inspections for this Examination.

We note that the vast majority of locations suggested are publicly accessible and we therefore intend to view those locations, where we consider additional visits would be useful, on an unaccompanied basis. Therefore, there is no need for us to undertake an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI). This has been removed from the Examination Timetable.

This means that there is no need for any Interested Parties to request attending any part of an ASI and thus the ExA has made a Procedural Decision to cancel **Procedural Deadline B** (8 November 2023).



Due to the private nature of the site, we propose to view the following site on an Access Required basis:

Aston Firs Caravan Site

This means whilst we will require access to the relevant parts of the site, we will not enter into any discussion with any parties present – whose role will be solely to grant access, open any locked gates and direct the ExA to the relevant part of the site. As this will require access to people's homes, we will be making arrangements with those involved separately. This inspection has therefore added to the Examination Timetable. We have also added the opportunity for those who attend the Access Required Site Inspection (ARSI) to make comments or submissions on the ARSI at **Deadline 4** (9 January 2024).
