

Burbage Common is an ancient grazing ground that was shared between the manors of Barwell, Burbage and Hinckley at the time the Doomsday Book was written in 1086. Burbage Wood is adjacent to the Common and has public access. It is owned and managed by Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council. The wood is dominated by a canopy of oak and ash, along with a field of maple and hazel to be found on the Common
