#### Good morning all,

Respondents cited examples such as: rail-connected port facilities in Ayr, Boston, Hull and Swansea; a number of "smaller" Intermodal terminals at Castle Donnington, Fratton and Telford; scrap metal facilities at Willesden and Snailwell; and sites in the Midlands such as Cottam Power Station, Coventry Prologis Park, and Rugeley Power Station. There is also reference to a facility in Ridham, Kent (which I think is a construction facility).

The questions in the CfE were framed in such a way that respondents have not provided a great deal of additional information about the viability of these sites. One respondent does cite Local economics and operational constraints as the key challenge. I am not in a position to comment on the viability of these facilities, but hopefully this helps.
