Dear Sirs,

We have lived on [REDACTED] Sapcote for [REDACTED] and our street adjoins Hinckley Road which is the centre of the village.

The effect of 24% increase in HGV vehicles will be catastrophic for our environment. Children and parents crossing Hinckley Road to access the school on Bassett Lane is an obvious hazard.

Air pollution will be increased causing yet another health hazard. The road is narrow - the road will become impassable should two hgv's vehicles meet coming in and out of the village. The road is totally unsuitable for large, noisy, heavy cumbersome traffic.

Furthermore, with the increase of a large number of lorries going through the village, vehicles turning right out [REDACTED], will find this manoeuvre difficult as well as hazardous.

The centre of Sapcote is congested already.

Our village coop on the corner of [REDACTED] t and Hinckley Road is busy, especially at school times and is used by other villages who do not have access to a general store.

Please note our objections once again. This awful planning application needs to be stopped as its impact will be catastrophic. It will not be safe for pedestrians, will be destructive to the environment and will be seriously detrimental to our village lives.
