I would like to again convey my objections to the proposed National Rail Freight Interchange planned for Hinckley.

I'm sure my objections will mirror many others you receive but nevertheless I feel it necessary to again mention a number of important issues that still fail to be satisfactorily resolved by the developers.

- * Why do we need this development when there are so many freight hubs within the surrounding area.
- * The hubs that exist have many units not being utilised and many more units still being built.
- * Why does this hub need to be proposed in an area of green space next to a Common thus absolutely spoiling the environment.
- * The impact on traffic will be enormous. Especially given that there are also massive house building proposals in Burbage, Sapcote and Stoney Stanton within just one mile of the Interchange. There are currently traffic jams both into Hinckley and along the M69 onto the M1.
- * The effect of this development will have a complete negative effect on the surrounding villages with minimal opportunities of incremental jobs.
